3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR A FEDERAL ENERGY

4 REGULATORY COMMISSION PROJECT IN-5 VOLVING CLARK CANYON DAM.

Notwithstanding the time period described in section
7 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would
8 otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Com9 mission project numbered 12429, the Federal Energy

Regulatory Commission (referred to in this section as the 1 "Commission") shall, at the request of the licensee for the 2 3 project, and after reasonable notice and in accordance with the procedures of the Commission under that section, 4 5 reinstate the license and extend the time period during which the licensee is required to commence construction 6 7 of project works for the 3-year period beginning on the date of enactment of this Act. 8
