4 "In this chapter, the term 'Network' means the Afri5 can American Civil Rights Network established under sec6 tion 308402(a).

### 7 "§ 308402. African American Civil Rights Network

8 "(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall establish,
9 within the Service, a program to be known as the 'African
10 American Civil Rights Network'.

11 "(b) DUTIES OF SECRETARY.—In carrying out the12 Network, the Secretary shall—

"(1) review studies and reports to complement
and not duplicate studies of the historical importance of the African American civil rights movement
that may be underway or completed, such as the
Civil Rights Framework Study;

"(2) produce and disseminate appropriate educational materials relating to the African American
civil rights movement, such as handbooks, maps, interpretive guides, or electronic information;

"(3) enter into appropriate cooperative agreements and memoranda of understanding to provide
technical assistance under subsection (c); and

1	"(4)(A) create and adopt an official, uniform
2	symbol or device for the Network; and
3	"(B) issue regulations for the use of the symbol
4	or device adopted under subparagraph (A).
5	"(c) ELEMENTS.—The Network shall encompass the

## 1 "§ 308403. Cooperative agreements and memoranda 2 of understanding

"To achieve the purposes of this chapter and to en-3 sure effective coordination of the Federal and non-Federal 4 5 elements of the Network described in section 308402(c) 6 with System units and programs of the Service, the Sec-7 retary may enter into cooperative agreements and memo-8 randa of understanding with, and provide technical assist-9 ance to the heads of other Federal agencies, States, units 10 of local government, regional governmental bodies, and private entities.". 11
