4 GULL EGGS.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Interior (re-6 ferred to in this Act as the "Secretary") may allow the 7 collection by members of the Hoonah Indian Association 8 of the eggs of glaucous-winged gulls (Laurus glaucescens) 9 within Glacier Bay National Park (referred to in this Act 10 as the "Park") not more frequently than twice each cal-11 endar year at up to 5 locations within the Park, subject FLO13508

to any terms and conditions that the Secretary determines
 to be necessary.

3 (b) APPLICABLE LAW.—For the purposes of sections 4 203 and 816 of the Alaska National Interest Lands Con-5 servation Act (16 U.S.C. 410hh–2, 3126), the collection 6 of eggs of glaucous-winged gulls within the Park in ac-7 cordance with subsection (a) shall be considered to be a 8 use specifically permitted by that Act.

9 (c) HARVEST PLAN.—The Secretary shall establish 10 schedules, locations, and any additional terms and condi-11 tions that the Secretary determines to be necessary for 12 the harvesting of eggs of glaucous-winged gulls in the 13 Park, based on an annual harvest plan to be prepared by 14 the Secretary and the Hoonah Indian Association.
