1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## 3 SECTION 1. GAO CAPACITY MARKET IMPACT STUDY AND 4 REPORT.

5 Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment
6 of this Act, the Comptroller General of the United States
7 shall—

8 (1) conduct a study of the effects of forward ca-9 pacity auctions or other capacity mechanisms that

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1	have been established by Independent System Opera-
2	tors or Regional Transmission Organizations on—
3	(A) consumer prices for electricity;
4	(B) the installation of new electrical gen-
5	eration systems;
6	(C) the preservation of existing electrical
7	generation systems; and
8	(D) competition in energy markets, includ-
9	ing the potential for the use of undue market
10	power or manipulation in the auctions; and
11	(2) submit to the appropriate committees of
12	Congress a report describing the results of the study
13	conducted under paragraph (1), including an assess-
14	ment of whether the auctions or capacity mecha-
15	nisms are producing rates that are just and reason-
16	able.
