8	as critical electric infrastructure information by

12	mation that qualifies as critical energy infra-

14	gated by the Commission.

20	"(C) to ensure there are appropriate sanc-
21	tions in place for Commissioners, officers, em-
22	ployees, or agents of the Commission who
23	knowingly and willfully disclose critical electric
24	infrastructure information in a manner that is
25	not authorized under this section;

1	"(3) Considerations.—In promulgating regu-
2	lations and issuing orders under paragraph (2), the
3	Commission shall take into consideration the role of
4	State commissions in—
5	"(A) reviewing the prudence and cost of
6	investments;
7	"(B) determining the rates and terms of
8	conditions for electric services; and
9	"(C) ensuring the safety and reliability of
10	the bulk-power system and distribution facilities
11	within the respective jurisdictions of the State
12	commissions.
13	"(4) No required sharing of informa-
14	TION.—Nothing in this section requires a person or
15	entity in possession of critical electric infrastructure
16	information to share the information with Federal,
17	State, political subdivision, or tribal authorities, or
18	any other person or entity.
19	"(5) Disclosure of noncritical electric
20	INFRASTRUCTURE INFORMATION.—In carrying out
21	this section, the Commission shall segregate critical
22	electric infrastructure information within documents
23	and electronic communications, wherever feasible, to
24	facilitate disclosure of information that is not des-

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1 ignated as critical electric infrastructure informa-

2 tion."
