3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Shiloh National Mili-
5 tary Park Boundary Adjustment and Parker’s Crossroads
6 Battlefield Designation Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

8 In this Act:

9 (1) **AFFILIATED AREA.**—The term “affiliated
10 area” means the Parker’s Crossroads Battlefield es-

1 established as an affiliated area of the National Park
2 System by section 4(a).

3 (2) PARK.—The term “Park” means Shiloh
4 National Military Park, a unit of the National Park
5 System.

6 (3) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
7 the Secretary of the Interior.

8 **SEC. 3. AREAS TO BE ADDED TO SHILOH NATIONAL MILI-**
9 **TARY PARK.**

10 (a) ADDITIONAL AREAS.—The boundary of the Park
11 is modified to include the areas that are generally depicted
12 on the map entitled “Shiloh National Military Park, Pro-
13 posed Boundary Adjustment”, numbered 304/80,011, and
14 dated July 2014, and which are comprised of the fol-
15 lowing:

16 (1) Fallen Timbers Battlefield.

17 (2) Russell House Battlefield.

18 (3) Davis Bridge Battlefield.

19 (b) ACQUISITION AUTHORITY.—The Secretary may
20 acquire the land described in subsection (a) by donation,
21 purchase from willing sellers with donated or appropriated
22 funds, or exchange.

23 (c) ADMINISTRATION.—Any land acquired under this
24 section shall be administered as part of the Park.

1 **SEC. 4. ESTABLISHMENT OF AFFILIATED AREA.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Parker’s Crossroads Battlefield in
3 the State of Tennessee is established as an affiliated area
4 of the National Park System.

5 (b) DESCRIPTION OF AFFILIATED AREA.—The affli-
6 ated area shall consist of the area generally depicted with-
7 in the “Proposed Boundary” on the map entitled “Park-
8 er’s Crossroads Battlefield, Proposed Boundary”, num-
9 bered 903/80,073, and dated July 2014.

10 (c) ADMINISTRATION.—The affiliated area shall be
11 managed in accordance with—

12 (1) this Act; and

13 (2) any law generally applicable to units of the
14 National Park System.

15 (d) MANAGEMENT ENTITY.—The City of Parkers
16 Crossroads and the Tennessee Historical Commission
17 shall jointly be the management entity for the affiliated
18 area.

19 (e) COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS.—The Secretary
20 may provide technical assistance and enter into coopera-
21 tive agreements with the management entity for the pur-
22 pose of providing financial assistance for the marketing,
23 marking, interpretation, and preservation of the affiliated
24 area.

25 (f) LIMITED ROLE OF THE SECRETARY.—Nothing in
26 this Act authorizes the Secretary to acquire property at

1 the affiliated area or to assume overall financial responsi-
2 bility for the operation, maintenance, or management of
3 the affiliated area.

4 (g) GENERAL MANAGEMENT PLAN.—

5 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary, in consulta-
6 tion with the management entity, shall develop a
7 general management plan for the affiliated area in
8 accordance with section 100502 of title 54, United
9 States Code.

10 (2) TRANSMITTAL.—Not later than 3 years
11 after the date on which funds are made available to
12 carry out this Act, the Secretary shall submit to the
13 Committee on Natural Resources of the House of
14 Representatives and the Committee on Energy and
15 Natural Resources of the Senate the general man-
16 agement plan developed under paragraph (1).
