3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Crooked River Ranch
5 Fire Protection Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT, DESCHUTES CANYON-**
7 **STEELHEAD FALLS WILDERNESS STUDY**
8 **AREA BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT, OREGON.**

9 (a) BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT.—The boundary of the
10 Deschutes Canyon-Steelhead Falls Wilderness Study Area

1 is modified to exclude approximately 688 acres of public
2 land, as depicted on the map entitled “Deschutes Canyon-
3 Steelhead Falls Wilderness Study Area (WSA) Proposed
4 Boundary Adjustment” and dated September 26, 2018.

5 (b) EFFECT OF EXCLUSION.—

6 (1) IN GENERAL.—The public land excluded
7 from the Deschutes Canyon-Steelhead Falls Wilder-
8 ness Study Area under subsection (a)—

9 (A) is no longer subject to section 603(c)
10 of the Federal Land Policy and Management
11 Act of 1976 (43 U.S.C. 1782(c)); and

12 (B) shall be managed in accordance with—

13 (i) this section;

14 (ii) the Federal Land Policy and Man-
15 agement Act of 1976 (43 U.S.C. 1701 et
16 seq.); and

17 (iii) any applicable resource manage-
18 ment plan.

19 (2) MANAGEMENT.—The Secretary of the Inte-
20 rior shall manage the land excluded from the
21 Deschutes Canyon-Steelhead Falls Wilderness Study
22 Area under subsection (a) to improve fire resiliency
23 and forest health, including the conduct of wildfire
24 prevention and response activities, as appropriate.

1 (3) OFF-ROAD RECREATIONAL MOTORIZED
2 USE.—The Secretary of the Interior shall not permit
3 off-road recreational motorized use on the public
4 land excluded from the Deschutes Canyon-Steelhead
5 Falls Wilderness Study Area under subsection (a).
