9 (1) FEDERAL LAND.—The term "Federal land"

1	(A) the parcel of approximately 24 acres of
2	National Forest System land within the bound-

4	depicted as "NFS Lands Selected for Transfer"
5	on the map entitled "Forest Service to Brian

8	(B) any improvements to the National
9	Forest System land described in subparagraph

11	(2) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
12	the Secretary of Agriculture, acting through the

14	(3) Town.—The term "Town" means Brian

16	(b) Conveyance.—As soon as practicable after the
17	date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall convey
18	to the Town, without consideration and subject to any
19	terms and conditions that the Secretary determines to be
20	appropriate, all right, title, and interest of the United
21	States in and to the Federal land, to be used by the Town
22	for a public works facility or any other uses determined
23	to be necessary by the Town.
24	(c) BOUNDARY MODIFICATION.—On the conveyance
25	of the Federal land to the Town under subsection (b), the
