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Agua Caliente PV Power Plant



- Agua Caliente 1st project from NextLight acquisition
- 290 MW AC PPA signed with PG&E
- CPUC approved 6/7; major permits in place
- 65 miles east of Yuma, AZ near Dateland & Hyder
- 2,400 acres, existing 500kV transmission line adjacent

Copper Mountain 48 MW expansion; 58 MW Total



- 48 MW AC EPC agreement with Sempra Generation
- Expansion of 10 MW El Dorado site in Boulder City Nevada
- Construction velocity expected to be 2-3 times faster than El Dorado
- Plan to complete in 2010

Blythe PV Power Plant

Engineering, Procurement and Construction – Free Field

- Constructed in ~120 days
- PPA signed with Southern California Edison
- Largest PV Power Plant in California
