1 At the appropriate place, insert the following:
2 **SEC. ____ . STANDARDS FOR CERTAIN INCANDESCENT RE-**
3 **FLECTOR LAMPS AND REFLECTOR LAMPS.**

4 Section 325(i) of the Energy Policy and Conservation
5 Act (42 U.S.C. 6295(i)) is amended by adding at the end
6 the following:

7 “(9) CERTAIN INCANDESCENT REFLECTOR
8 LAMPS.—

9 “(A) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year
10 after the date of enactment of this paragraph,

1 the Secretary shall publish a final rule estab-
2 lishing standards for incandescent reflector
3 lamp types described in paragraph (1)(C).

4 “(B) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The standards
5 described in subparagraph (A) take effect on
6 the date that is 2 years after the date of publi-
7 cation of the final rule.

8 “(C) FAILURE TO ESTABLISH STAND-
9 ARDS.—If the Secretary fails to publish a final
10 rule in accordance with subparagraph (A), ef-
11 fective beginning on the date that is 3 years
12 after the date of enactment of this paragraph,
13 the minimum standard for lamp types described
14 in paragraph (1)(C) shall be the same as the
15 standard for other incandescent reflector lamps
16 established by the Secretary pursuant to this
17 subsection.

18 “(D) STANDARDS.—In conducting a rule-
19 making for incandescent reflector lamps under
20 this paragraph after the date of enactment of
21 this paragraph, the Secretary shall consider the
22 standards for all incandescent reflector lamps.

23 “(10) REFLECTOR LAMPS.—

24 “(A) IN GENERAL.—Not later than Janu-
25 ary 1, 2015, the Secretary shall publish a final

1 rule establishing and amending standards for
2 reflector lamps, including incandescent reflector
3 lamps.

4 “(B) TECHNOLOGIES.—In conducting the
5 rulemaking under this paragraph, the Secretary
6 shall consider incandescent and nonincandes-
7 cent technologies.

8 “(C) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The standards
9 described in subparagraph (A) take effect not
10 earlier than the date that is 3 years after the
11 date of publication of the final rule, as deter-
12 mined by the Secretary.”.
