A BILL

To extend the authorizations for certain National Heritage Areas, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Heritage
5 Area Authority Extension Act of 2021”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF CERTAIN NATIONAL HERITAGE**
7 **AREA AUTHORITIES.**

11 tural Heritage Partnership established by section
12 703(a) of division II of the Omnibus Parks and Pub-
13 lic Lands Management Act of 1996 (Public Law
14 104–333; 110 Stat. 4266) shall be known and des-
15 ignated as the “Silos & Smokestacks National Herit-
16 age Area”.

17 (2) **REFERENCES.**—Any reference in a law,
18 map, regulation, document, paper, or other record of
19 the United States to the partnership referred to in
20 subsection (a) shall be deemed to be a reference to
21 the “Silos & Smokestacks National Heritage Area”.
