Title VII—Vehicles and Fuels (END05361.LC)

Viz:

1 On page 2, strike lines 23 and 24 and insert the fol-
2 lowing:

3 “The authority provided by sections 501, 507, and
4 508 terminates the earlier of—

5 “(1) September 30, 2015; or

6 “(2) the date, the Secretary has established, by
7 rule, a replacement program that achieves the goals
8 of those sections.”.

1 On page 3, line 18, strike “may” and insert “shall”.

2 On page 3, line 25, insert “cumulative” after “per-
3 cent”.

4 On page 4, line 4, insert “annual” after “the”.

5 On page 4, line 6, insert “cumulative” before “alter-
6 native”.

7 On page 4, between lines 16 and 17, insert the fol-
8 lowing:

9 (b) CREDITS.—Section 508(a) of the Energy Policy
10 Act of 1992 (42 U.S.C. 13258(a)) is amended—

11 (1) by striking “The Secretary” and inserting
12 the following:

13 “(1) The Secretary”; and

14 (2) by adding at the end the following:

15 “(2) Not later than January 31, 2007, the Sec-
16 retary shall—

17 “(A) allocate credit in an amount to be de-
18 termined by the Secretary for—

19 “(i) acquisition of—

20 “(I) a light-duty hybrid electric
21 vehicle;

1 “(II) a plug-in hybrid electric ve-
2 hicle;

3 “(III) a fuel cell electric vehicle;

4 “(IV) a medium- or heavy-duty
5 hybrid electric vehicle;

6 “(V) a neighborhood electric ve-
7 hicle; or

8 “(VI) a medium- or heavy-duty
9 dedicated vehicle; and

10 “(ii) investment in qualified alter-
11 native fuel infrastructure or nonroad
12 equipment, as determined by the Sec-
13 retary; and

14 “(B) allocate more than 1, but not to ex-
15 ceed 5, credits for investment in an emerging
16 technology relating to any vehicle described in
17 subparagraph (A) to encourage—

18 “(i) a reduction in petroleum demand;

19 “(ii) technological advancement; and

20 “(iii) environmental safety.”

21 On page 4, line 17, strike “(b)” and insert “(c)”.
