1       Beginning on page 1, strike line 8 and all that follows  
2 through page 2, line 22, and insert the following:  
3           (1) NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LAND.—Admin-  
4 istrative jurisdiction over the approximately 160  
5 acres of National Forest System land, as generally  
6 depicted on the map entitled “Ackerson Meadow  
7 Land Interchange” and dated February 24, 2022, is  
8 transferred to the Secretary of the Interior to be  
9 managed as part of Yosemite National Park, in ac-  
10 cordance with laws applicable to the National Park  
11 System.

1           (2) NATIONAL PARK SYSTEM LAND.—Adminis-  
2       trative jurisdiction over the approximately 170 acres  
3       of National Park System land, as generally depicted  
4       on the map entitled “Ackerson Meadow Land Inter-  
5       change” and dated February 24, 2022, is trans-  
6       ferred to the Secretary of Agriculture to be managed  
7       as part of Stanislaus National Forest in accordance  
8       with laws applicable to the National Forest System.
