1 On page 137, strike line 17 and insert the following:

2 **SEC. 2203. CAP ON ETHANE ADDED TO LIQUEFIED NAT-**

3 **URAL GAS.**

4 Section 3(e) of the Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C.

5 717b(e)) is amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “(5) CAP ON ETHANE.—Excluding LNG ex-

7 ported from Alaska, any LNG that is exported shall

8 have a maximum heating value of not more than

9 1,110 BTU per standard cubic foot of dry gas,

10 which is consistent with the quality specifications of

11 a majority of interstate pipelines.”.

1 **SEC. 2204. ANNUAL REPORTS ON LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS.**

2 The Secretary shall submit to Congress an annual re-  
3 port on—

4 (1) the total quantity of liquefied natural gas  
5 exported from the United States; and

6 (2) each country to which liquefied natural gas  
7 is exported, including the quantity of liquefied nat-  
8 ural gas exported to each country.
