A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to establish a bison management plan for Grand Canyon National Park.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

$\mathbf{2}$ 1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.** 2 This Act may be cited as the "Grand Canyon Bison 3 Management Act". **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.** 4 5 In this Act: 6 (1) MANAGEMENT PLAN.—The term "manage-7 ment plan" means the management plan published 8 under section 3(a). (2) PARK.—The term "Park" means the Grand 9 10 Canyon National Park. 11 (3) SECRETARY.—The term "Secretary" means 12 the Secretary of the Interior. 13 (4) SKILLED PUBLIC VOLUNTEER.—The term "skilled public volunteer" means an individual who 14 15 possesses-

16 (A) a valid hunting license issued by the17 State of Arizona; and

18 (B) such other qualifications as the Sec19 retary may require, after consultation with the
20 Arizona Game and Fish Commission.

21 SEC. 3. BISON MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR GRAND CANYON 22 NATIONAL PARK.

(a) PUBLICATION OF PLAN.—Not later than 180
24 days after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary
25 shall publish a management plan to reduce, through hu26 mane lethal culling by skilled public volunteers and by

other nonlethal means, the population of bison in the Park
 that the Secretary determines are detrimental to the use
 of the Park.

4 (b) REMOVAL OF ANIMAL.—Notwithstanding section
5 4 of the Act of March 2, 1929 (16 U.S.C. 198c), or any
6 other provision of law, a skilled public volunteer may re7 move a full bison harvested from the Park.

8 (c) COORDINATION.—The Secretary shall coordinate 9 with the Arizona Game and Fish Commission regarding 10 the development and implementation of the management 11 plan.

(d) NEPA COMPLIANCE.—In developing the management plan, the Secretary shall comply with all applicable
Federal environmental laws (including regulations), including the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969
(42 U.S.C. 4321 et seq.).

(e) LIMITATION.—Nothing in this Act applies to thetaking of wildlife in the Park for any purpose other thanthe implementation of the management plan.
