3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Secure Rural Schools
5	Reauthorization Act of 2019".
6	SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF SECURE RURAL SCHOOLS AND COM-
7	MUNITY SELF-DETERMINATION ACT OF 2000.
8	(a) Definition of Full Funding Amount.—Sec-
9	tion 3(11) of the Secure Rural Schools and Community
10	Self-Determination Act of 2000 (16 U.S.C. 7102(11)) is
11	amended by striking subparagraphs (D) and (E) and in-
12	serting the following:

1	"(D) for fiscal year 2017, the amount that
2	is equal to 95 percent of the full funding
3	amount for fiscal year 2015;
4	"(E) for fiscal year 2018, the amount that
5	is equal to 95 percent of the full funding
6	amount for fiscal year 2017; and
7	"(F) for fiscal year 2019 and each fiscal
8	year thereafter, the amount that is equal to the
9	full funding amount for fiscal year 2017.".

22	tion Act of 2000 (16 U.S.C. 7112(b)(1)(D)) is

24	(i) in the subparagraph heading, by

23	'applicable designee' means the applicable re-

1	"(B) NATIONAL PILOT PROGRAM.—The
2	term 'national pilot program' means the na-
3	tional pilot program established under para-
4	graph (4)(A).
5	"(C) REGIONAL PILOT PROGRAM.—The
6	term 'regional pilot program' means the re-
7	gional pilot program established under para-
8	graph $(3)(A)$.
9	"(2) Establishment of pilot programs.—
10	In accordance with paragraphs (3) and (4), the Sec-
11	retary concerned shall carry out 2 pilot programs to
12	appoint members of resource advisory committees.
13	"(3) Regional pilot program.—
14	"(A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary con-
15	cerned shall carry out a regional pilot program
16	to allow an applicable designee to appoint mem-
17	bers of resource advisory committees.
18	"(B) Geographic Limitation.—The re-
19	gional pilot program shall only apply to re-
20	source advisory committees chartered in—
21	"(i) the State of Montana; and
22	"(ii) the State of Arizona.
23	"(C) Responsibilities of applicable
24	DESIGNEE.—

1	"(i) Review.—Before appointing a
2	member of a resource advisory committee
3	under the regional pilot program, an appli-
4	cable designee shall conduct the review and
5	analysis that would otherwise be conducted
6	for an appointment to a resource advisory
7	committee if the regional pilot program
8	was not in effect, including any review and
9	analysis with respect to civil rights and
10	budgetary requirements.
11	"(ii) Savings clause.—Nothing in
12	this paragraph relieves an applicable des-
13	ignee from any requirement developed by
14	the Secretary concerned for making an ap-
15	pointment to a resource advisory com-
16	mittee that is in effect on December 20,
17	2018, including any requirement for adver-
18	tising a vacancy.
19	"(4) National pilot program.—
20	"(A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary con-
21	cerned shall carry out a national pilot program
22	to allow the Chief of the Forest Service or the
23	Director of the Bureau of Land Management,
24	as applicable, to submit to the Secretary con-
25	cerned nominations of individuals for appoint-

1	ment as members of resource advisory commit-
2	tees.
3	"(B) Appointment.—Under the national
4	pilot program, subject to subparagraph (C), not
5	later than 30 days after the date on which a
6	nomination is transmitted to the Secretary con-
7	cerned under subparagraph (A), the Secretary
8	concerned shall—
9	"(i) appoint the nominee to the appli-
10	cable resource advisory committee; or
11	"(ii) reject the nomination.
12	"(C) AUTOMATIC APPOINTMENT.—If the
13	Secretary concerned does not act on a nomina-
14	tion in accordance with subparagraph (B) by
15	the date described in that subparagraph, the
16	nominee shall be deemed appointed to the appli-
17	cable resource advisory committee.
18	"(D) Geographic Limitation.—The na-
19	tional pilot program shall apply to a resource
20	advisory committee chartered in any State other
21	than—
22	"(i) the State of Montana; or
23	"(ii) the State of Arizona.
24	"(E) SAVINGS CLAUSE.—Nothing in this
25	paragraph relieves the Secretary concerned

1	from any requirement relating to an appoint
2	ment to a resource advisory committee, includ-
3	ing any requirement with respect to civil rights
4	or advertising a vacancy.
5	"(5) TERMINATION OF EFFECTIVENESS.—The
6	authority provided under this subsection terminates
7	on October 1, 2023.
8	"(6) Report to congress.—Not later 180
9	days after the date described in paragraph (5), the
10	Secretary concerned shall submit to Congress a re-
11	port that includes—
12	"(A) with respect to appointments made
13	under the regional pilot program compared to
14	appointments made under the national pilot
15	program, a description of the extent to which—
16	"(i) appointments were faster or slow-
17	er; and
18	"(ii) the requirements described in
19	paragraph (3)(C)(i) differ; and
20	"(B) a recommendation with respect to
21	whether Congress should terminate, continue
22	modify, or expand the pilot programs.".

9	Determination Act of 2000 (16 U.S.C. 7128) is
10	amended—
11	(A) in subsection (a), by striking "2020"
12	and inserting "2022"; and
13	(B) in subsection (b), by striking "2021"
14	and inserting "2023".
15	(e) Extension of Authority To Expend County
16	Funds.—Section 304 of the Secure Rural Schools and
17	Community Self-Determination Act of 2000 (16 U.S.C.
18	7144) is amended—
19	(1) in subsection (a), by striking "2020" and
20	inserting "2022"; and
21	(2) in subsection (b), by striking "2021" and
22	inserting "2023".
23	(f) Amounts Obligated but Unspent; Prohibi-
24	TION ON USE OF FUNDS.—Title III of the Secure Rural

1	Schools and Community Self-Determination Act of 2000
2	(16 U.S.C. 7141 et seq.) is amended—
3	(1) by redesignating section 304 as section 305;
4	and
5	(2) by inserting after section 303 the following:
6	"SEC. 304. AMOUNTS OBLIGATED BUT UNSPENT; PROHIBI-
7	TION ON USE OF FUNDS.
8	"(a) Amounts Obligated but Unspent.—Any
9	county funds that were obligated by the applicable partici-
10	pating county before October 1, 2017, but are unspent on
11	October 1, 2019—
12	"(1) may, at the option of the participating
13	county, be deemed to have been reserved by the par-
14	ticipating county on October 1, 2019, for expendi-
15	ture in accordance with this title; and
16	"(2)(A) may be used by the participating coun-
17	ty for any authorized use under section 302(a); and
18	"(B) on a determination by the participating
19	county under subparagraph (A) to use the county
20	funds, shall be available for projects initiated after
21	October 1, 2019, subject to section 305.
22	"(b) Prohibition on Use of Funds.—Notwith-
23	standing any other provision of law, effective beginning
24	on the date of enactment of the Secure Rural Schools Re-
25	authorization Act of 2019, no county funds made available

1 under this title may be used by any participating county

- 2 for any lobbying activity, regardless of the purpose for
- 3 which the funds are obligated on or before that date.".
