AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. BARRASSO to the amendment (No. \_\_\_\_\_) proposed by Mr. PORTMAN

Viz:

1 At the end of the amendment, add the following:

2 **SEC. 3. GAO STUDY.**

3 Not later than 2 years after the date of enactment  
4 of this Act, the Comptroller General of the United States  
5 shall—

6 (1) conduct a study with respect to the imple-  
7 mentation of the National Park Service Legacy Res-  
8 toration Fund under section 104908 of title 54,  
9 United States Code (as added by section 2(a)) (re-

1       ferred to in this section as the “Fund”), including  
2       whether the Director of the National Park Service  
3       is, with respect to projects carried out using  
4       amounts from the Fund—

5               (A) properly estimating the cost for those  
6       projects;

7               (B) adhering to time schedules and cost  
8       projections for those projects;

9               (C) properly prioritizing deferred mainte-  
10      nance projects; and

11              (D) properly moving completed projects off  
12      of the high-priority deferred maintenance list of  
13      the National Park Service in a timely manner;  
14      and

15              (2) submit to Congress a report that describes  
16      the results of the study under paragraph (1).
