3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Continental Divide Na-
5	tional Scenic Trail Completion Act".
6	SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.
7	In this Act:
8	(1) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
9	the Secretary of Agriculture.
10	(2) TRAIL.—The term "Trail" means the Con-
11	tinantal Divida National Scanic Trail

1	(3) Trail completion team.—The term
2	"Trail Completion Team" means the joint Forest
3	Service-Bureau of Land Management Trail comple-
4	tion team established under section 4(a).
5	SEC. 3. COMPLETION OF CONTINENTAL DIVIDE NATIONAL
6	SCENIC TRAIL.
7	Subject to the availability of appropriations, the Sec-
8	retary and the Secretary of the Interior shall seek to com-
9	plete the Trail as a continuous route not later than the
10	50th anniversary of the date of designation of the Trail
11	as a national scenic trail.
12	SEC. 4. TRAIL COMPLETION TEAM.
13	(a) In General.—Not later than 1 year after the
14	date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary and the Sec-
15	retary of the Interior shall establish a joint Forest Service-
16	Bureau of Land Management Trail completion team to
17	work in coordination with the administrator of the Trail—
18	(1) to facilitate the completion and optimization
19	of the Trail, consistent with the purposes of the
20	Trail; and
21	(2) to assist in the development of the com-
22	prehensive development plan for the Trail under sec-
23	tion 5.
24	(b) Consultation.—As appropriate, the Trail Com-
25	pletion Team shall consult with other Federal agencies,

1	affected State, Tribal, and local governments, landowners,
2	affected land-grant mercedes owners and users, acequias,
3	and other interested parties in—
4	(1) the completion and optimization of the
5	Trail; and
6	(2) the development and completion of the com-
7	prehensive development plan for the Trail under sec-
8	tion 5.
9	SEC. 5. COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE
10	CONTINENTAL DIVIDE NATIONAL SCENIC
11	TRAIL.
12	(a) In General.—Not later than 3 years after the
13	date of establishment of the Trail Completion Team under
14	section 4(a), the Secretary shall complete a comprehensive
15	development plan for the Trail.
16	(b) Plan Inclusions.—The comprehensive develop-
17	ment plan under subsection (a) shall—
18	(1) identify any gaps in the Trail for which the
19	Secretary and the Secretary of the Interior have not
20	been able to acquire land;
21	(2) identify opportunities for the use of ease-
22	ments acquired from willing sellers to facilitate com-
23	pletion of the Trail; and

1	(3) include general and site-specific Trail devel-
2	opment plans, including anticipated costs of the
3	plans.
4	SEC. 6. PARTNERSHIPS.
5	The Secretary and the Secretary of the Interior shall
6	seek to enter into agreements with volunteer and nonprofit
7	organizations, as appropriate, to facilitate the completion
8	and administration of the Trail.
9	SEC. 7. EFFECT.
10	Nothing in this Act—
11	(1) provides any authority to acquire land or in-
12	terests in land for inclusion in the Trail beyond the
13	authorities provided for the Trail in the National
14	Trails System Act (16 U.S.C. 1241 et seq.), includ-
15	ing acquisition by eminent domain; or
16	(2) makes the acquisition of land or interests in
17	land for the Trail a priority over other land acquisi-
18	tion authorizations.
