1 In section 1003(d), strike paragraph (1) and insert  
2 the following:

3 (1) DEVELOPMENT.—

4 (A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary, in col-  
5 laboration with the Secretary of Homeland Se-  
6 curity, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commis-  
7 sion, the North American Electric Reliability  
8 Corporation, and interested energy infrastruc-  
9 ture stakeholders and other private sector and  
10 academic stakeholders, shall develop common

1            analytical frameworks, tools, metrics, and data  
2            to assess the resilience, reliability, safety, and  
3            security of energy infrastructure in the United  
4            States, including by developing and storing an  
5            inventory of easily transported high-voltage re-  
6            covery transformers and other required equip-  
7            ment.

8            (B) REQUIREMENT.—In carrying out para-  
9            graph (1), the Secretary shall include frame-  
10           works, tools, metrics, and data based on climate  
11           science to assess the current and future  
12           vulnerabilities and risks to energy infrastruc-  
13           ture due to sea-level rise and other impacts as-  
14           sociated with climate change.
